*State law requires the district to give you the following information:*

Certain information about district students is considered directory information and will be released to anyone who follows the procedures for requesting the information unless the parent or guardian objects to the release of the directory information about the student. If you do not want Pine Tree ISD to disclose directory information from your child's education records without your prior written consent, you must notify the district in writing by September 17, 2007 or within ten school days of your child's first day of instruction.

This means that the district must give certain personal information (called "directory information") about your child to any person who requests it, unless you have told the district in writing not to do so. In addition, you have the right to tell the district that it may or may not use certain personal information about your child for specific school sponsored purposes. The district is providing you with this form so you can communicate your wishes about these issues.

For limited school-sponsored purposes (student recognition activities, yearbook, district website or school newspaper, printed programs for extracurricular activities, news releases to local media, etc.), the district has designated the following information as directory information:

- Dates of attendance
- Photograph
